Requirements:

a) attend and record as described in class a school board meeting,

Attend a school board meeting (Union, Towns, or other system) and put together the following:

- Agenda and pertinent handouts of the board meeting
- Narrative – 1-2 pages 12 point Times New Roman font using APA style (double spaced). This is to be a description of the action taken at the school board meeting.

b) attend and record as described in class a school function such as a PTA, PTO, open site-based decision making council

Attend a meeting as described above and provide the following:

- Agenda and pertinent handouts of the meeting
- Narrative – 1-2 pages 12 point Times New Roman font using APA style (double spaced). This is to be a description of the action taken at the meeting.

c) Interview (record as per class description) a practicing classroom teacher

Interview a K-12 public school classroom teacher using the components expected in your Philosophy of Education paper – 1) The purpose of education 2) Preferred instructional strategies 3) Classroom management style 4) Ethical role of the teacher in the classroom and community 5) Why be a teacher?

Produce a 2-3 page paper using APA style (double spaced) and include your notes from the interview along with the paper.
