Suggested Guidelines for Class Presentation 4/27/10

(You may wish to print this and have to use as guidelines for the presentation.)

- a. Give your name and area in which you expect to teach.
- b. Go to your Unit folder and open
- c. Identify the following for the unit:
 - a. Age, level, subject area, and/or content
 - b. Please open one lesson plan from the unit and identify the following:
 - i. The overall goals for the unit
 - ii. Objectives – Georgia Performance Standards
 - iii. Motivation
 - iv. One (1) activity – (briefly describe and indicate if it is (T)eacher or (S)tudent Centered and how much time will be required.
 - v. Open one (1) supporting document for the above activity (notes, assessment, etc,)
 - vi. Assessment – identify one formal and one informal assessment for the lesson plan (optional – open one of the above assessments for audience to see)
 - vii. Identify one method of incorporating technology into the above lesson plan
 - viii. Identify one method you will use to address ‘cultural differences’ (diversity) in this lesson plan.
 - ix. Identify one method you will use to address ‘at risk’ students in the lesson plan, i.e. accommodation for special needs students
- d. Go to the electronic portfolio and address the following:
 - a. Identify components of the ‘Index’ page
 - b. Open the folder for EDUC 2210 and identify the artifacts – open the one that you think best represents your work for

the semester – Quickly identify and supply your reasoning for why you consider it your strongest artifact.

- c. Focus on the INTASC folders and identify that these are the standards that all new teachers going into the classroom are expected to meet. Do this by opening the top INTASC folder so that all ten are viewed by the audience. Quickly go back to the 'Index' page and open one of the INTASC folders and identify the artifact that you have placed there that is evidence that indicates you can meet that particular standard.
- d. Focus on the NETS Standards and do the same as with the INTASC Standards.
- e. Tell us of your future plans.

Please be concise and hold to no more than ten minutes. Please do not hurry and cut the presentation short while failing to discuss the above with your audience.
